Feast of the Discovery of the Holy Cross

The Feast of the Discovery of the Holy Cross is one of the four feasts dedicated to Christ's Holy Christ. In 327 AD Heghineh, the Mother of the Byzantine King Kostandianos, visited Jerusalem with the aim to search the holy Cross of the Lord. A Jew, named Judas, helped the King's mother to search the site where Christ was crucified - Golgotha. In the result of searches the wooden crosses of Christ and the two criminals crucified together with him were found. For recognizing the Lord's Cross, the remains of a young man were put on the crosses in turn. On one of the crosses the young man raised to life and thus the Lord's Cross was identified. After that miracle the Jew converted to Christianity and later became the Bishop Cyril of Jerusalem. After the discovery of the Holy Cross Heghineh renovated the Holy Places of Jerusalem and built the Church of Holy Resurrection of Golgotha, where later the Lord's cross was installed.

The Armenian Apostolic Church celebrates the Feast of the Discovery of the Holy Cross on the Sunday during the period October 23-29.

TODAY'S SCRIPTURE READINGS

The first reading is from the First Letter of Paul to Corinthians (1:18-24)

For the message about the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God. For it is written, "I will destroy the wisdom of the wise, and the discernment of the discerning I will thwart." Where is the one who is wise? Where is the scholar? Where is the debater of this age? Has not God made foolish the wisdom of the world? For since, in the wisdom of God, the world did not know God through wisdom, God decided, through the foolishness of the proclamation, to save those who believe. For Jews ask for signs and Greeks desire wisdom, but we proclaim Christ crucified, a stumbling block to Jews and foolishness to gentiles, but to those who are the called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God and the wisdom of God.

The second reading is from the Holy Gospel of Jesus Christ according to Matthew (24:27-36)

For as lightning that comes from the east is visible even in the west, so will be the coming of the Son of Man. Wherever there is a carcass, there the vultures will gather. "Immediately after the distress of those days" "the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light; the stars will fall from the sky, and the heavenly bodies will be shaken." "Then will appear the sign of the Son of Man in heaven. And then all the peoples of the earth will mourn when they see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven, with power and great glory. And he will send his angels with a loud trumpet call, and they will gather his elect from the four winds, from one end of the heavens to the other. "Now learn this lesson from the fig tree: As soon as its twigs get tender and its leaves come out, you know that summer is near. Even so, when you see all these things, you know that it is near, right at the door. Truly I tell you, this generation will certainly not pass away until all these things have happened. Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will never pass away.
